Dee Apple, Ph.D.: Dr. Apple is a licensed clinical psychologist in New Jersey. He is a member of the Board of Regents of the American College of Orgonomy, and is a Clinical Associate at the ACO. He maintains a private practice in Princeton, New Jersey, working with children, adolescents, adults and couples. He is also a member of the counseling and psychological services team at the Lawrenceville School. Dr. Apple received his BA from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, where he graduated Phi Beta Kappa. He received his Ph.D. at the University of South Dakota. He is on the faculty of the ACO's social orgonomy training program and is also director of the College's CORE research group. He has published articles in the *Journal of Orgonomy*. He will assist in the laboratory.

Edward Chastka, M.D.: Dr. Chastka is board certified in psychiatry and medical orgonomy and is in private practice in Wyomissing, Pennsylvania where he treats children, adolescents, adults, and families. He is a member of the American College of Orgonomy and is a member of the ACO's Social Orgonomy Training Committee.
